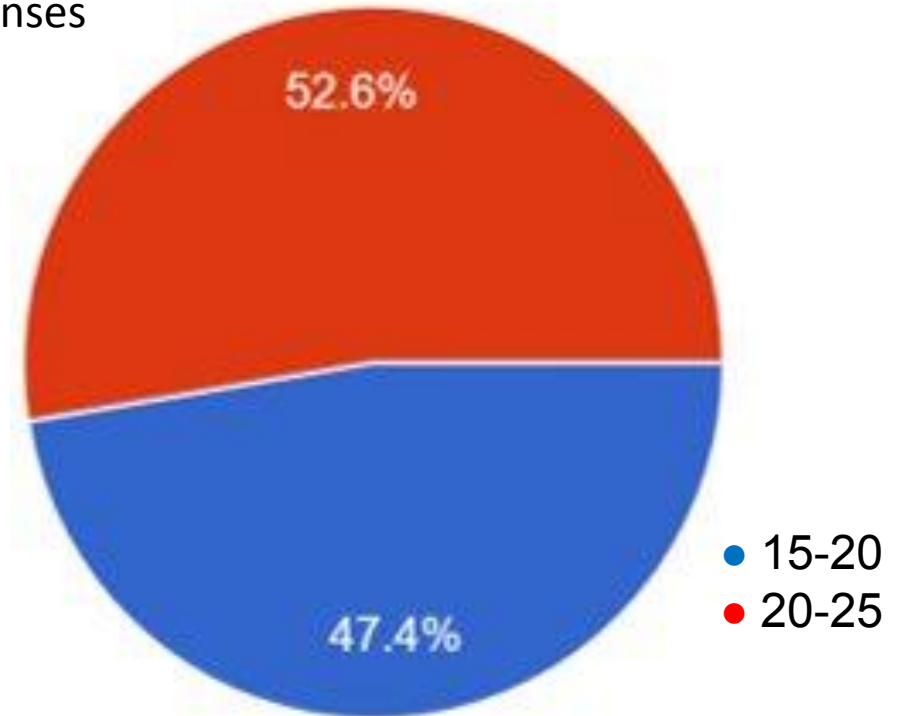

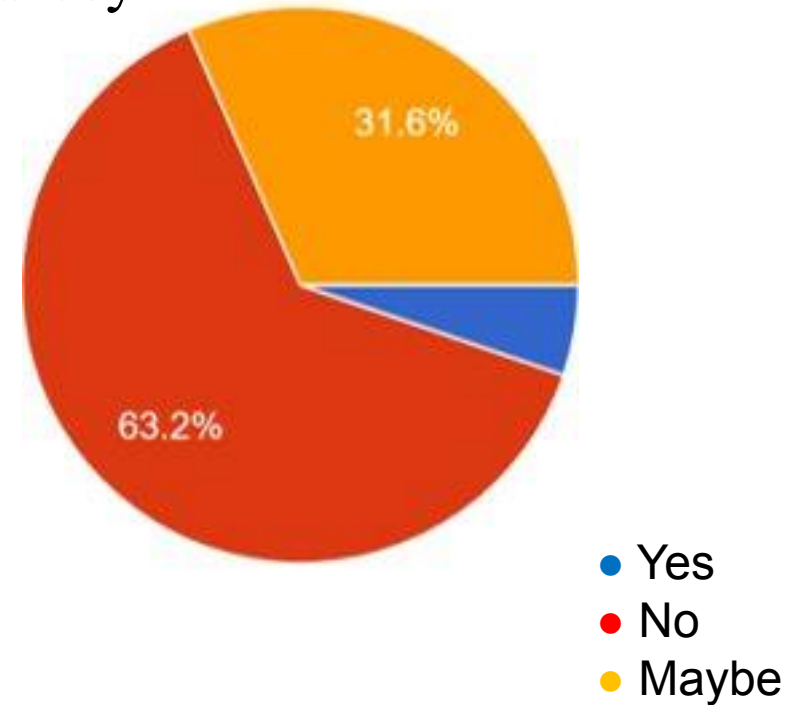


Do you plan to go to abroad in the future?

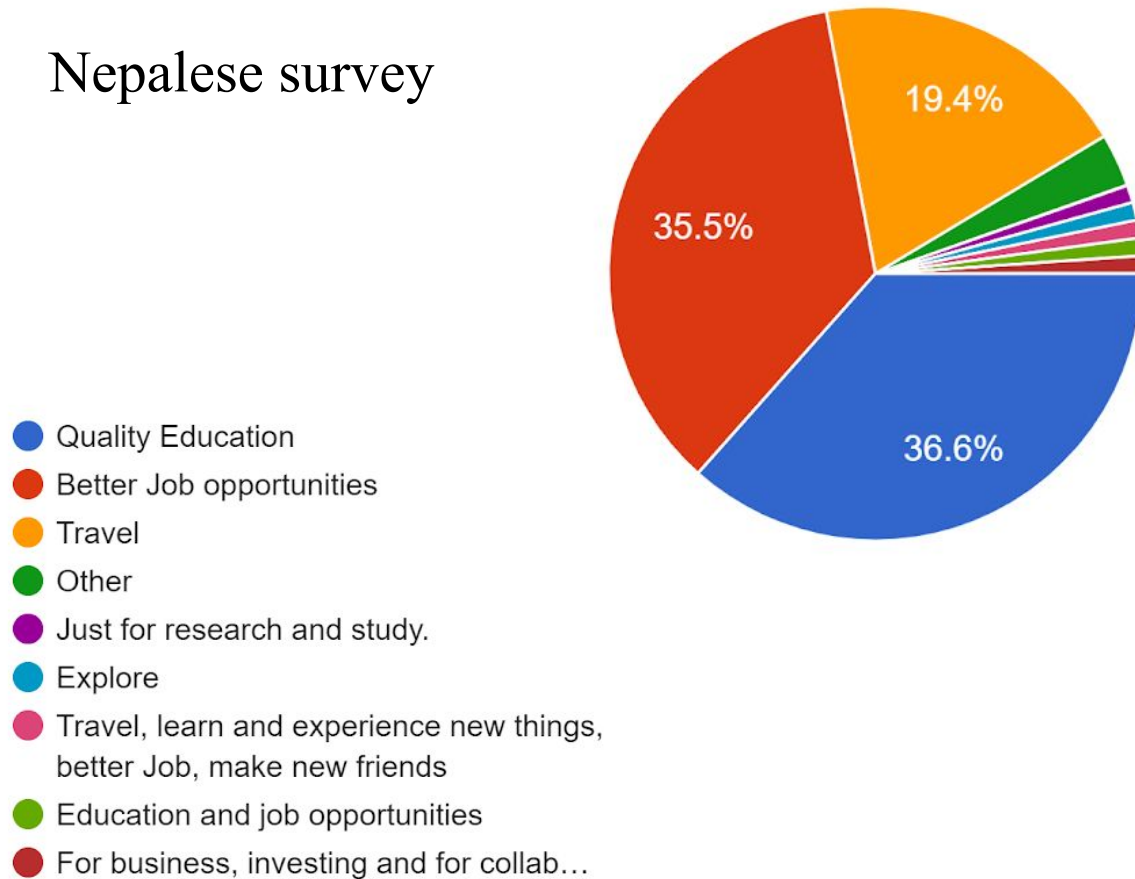

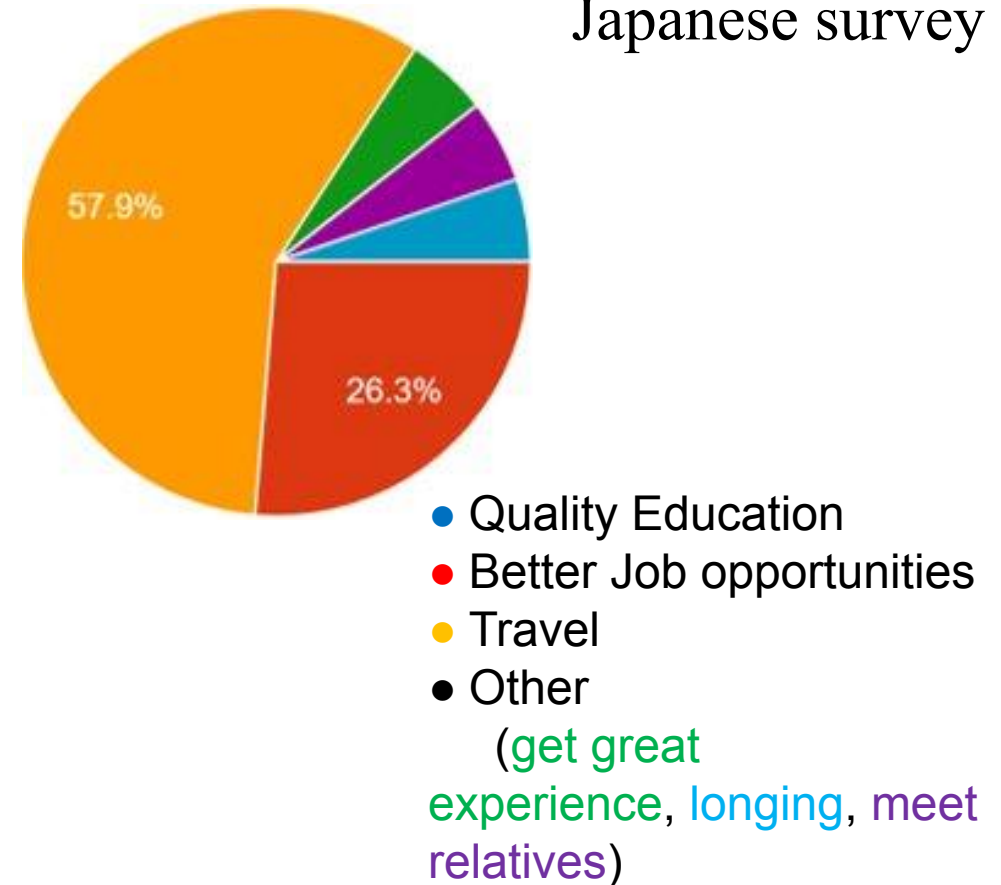


Why do you plan to go abroad?

Findings



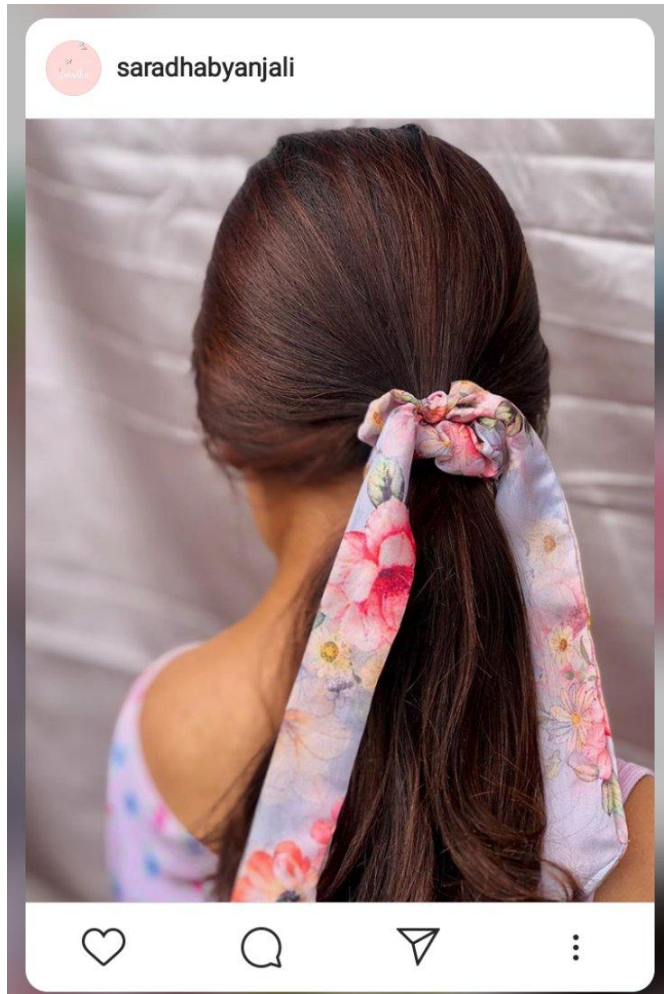
- Comparatively , Nepalese are more interested to go aboard than Japanese people.

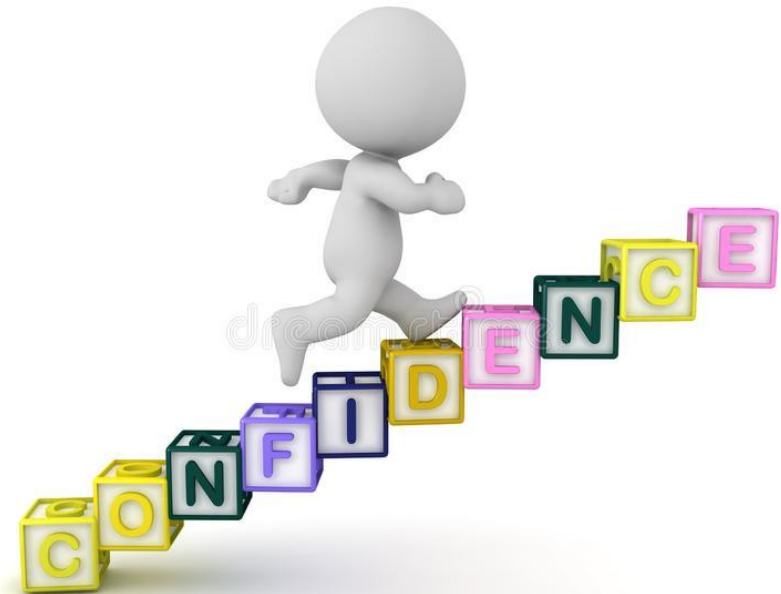
